Anti-Bullying

Our message is simple: Bullying will not be tolerated at our school - you must **TELL** an adult.

As part of our anti-bullying work this term we are looking at respect which links directly to our three Doobee Rules which are, Do be respectful of yourself, Do be respectful of others and Do be proud of your school.

We have been looking at the definition of bullying, the different forms that it can take and what the children should do if either they are being bullied or they know someone who is. We have agreed that bullying is repeated behaviour that overtime causes distress and pain to the victim, but it is not falling out or a one-off incident.

We have agreed that bullying can be:

- Emotional - being unfriendly, excluding, tormenting (e.g. hiding books, threatening gestures);
- Physical - pushing, kicking, hitting, punching or any use of violence;
- Racist - racial taunts, graffiti, gestures;
- Verbal - name-calling, sarcasm, spreading rumours, teasing;
- Cyber - all areas of internet, such as email & internet chat rooms, misuse of mobiles such as sending threats by text messaging & calls.

We encourage children to **TELL** an adult straight away if either they or someone they know is being bullied. For further details, please refer to our Anti- Bullying Policy published on our website.
