Harvest Assembly



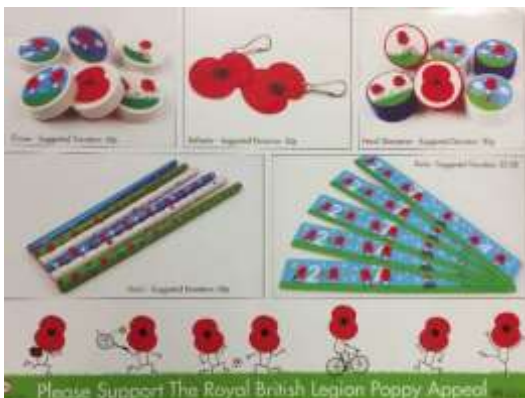
