Christmas Fair Friday, 30th November 2018

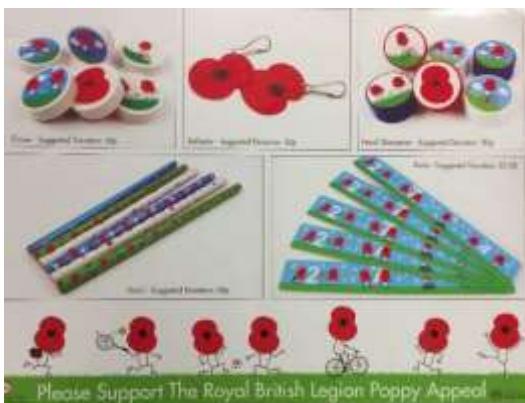
Non-School Uniform Day tomorrow Thursday, 25th October 2018
