A huge thank you to everyone who sent in donations for our chocolate tombola. It is greatly appreciated.

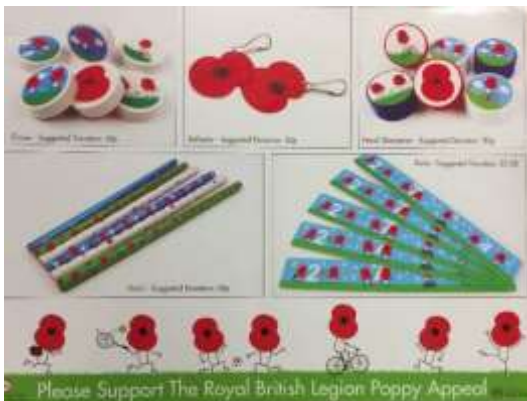


**Non-School Uniform Day

During the month of December the school nurses will be coming into school to vaccinate all children in Reception, Year 1, 2, 3,4 and 5. Please return all letters as soon as possible.

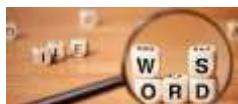


Monsters' Ball
