All of our children will be assigned a group known as a 'bubble'. They will only be taught with children and staff in their bubble and will not mix with other bubbles. In order to keep everybody safe and ease congestion through our walkways we are staggering the start and finish times for different year groups.

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At first we are only running a skeleton breakfast club and after school club as we need to keep children within their bubbles for this provision. Please contact school before Friday 24th July if you will need either provision. In the first instance, we will not be operating the school mini buses for collecting or dropping off the children.

Please be assured that we will do the following:

- Assign each child to a group known as a 'bubble'.
- Ensure the children in each bubble do not have contact with children in a different bubble in school.
- Stagger the start and finish time of each bubble and give each bubble an entry and exit point to school.
- Stagger playtimes and lunch times.
- Talk to the children and continually reinforce how to keep safe in school, including social distancing and regular hand washing.
- Ensure all children regularly wash their hands, including on arrival at school.
- Install more hand washing facilities in school.
- Ensure each child has their own designated workspace and resources.
- Ensure parents can socially distance when the children are dropped off and collected.
- Take the children's temperature as they arrive at school.
- A cleaner will be on site to regularly clean the bathroom facilities and each evening the classroom and the resources the children use will be deep cleaned.
- Continue to teach a broad and balanced curriculum.



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Please could we ask that parents do the following:

- Only one parent or carer to come to school when dropping off or collecting.
- Only come to school at your child's allotted time.
- Ensure your child comes to school in their uniform.
- **Please ensure that your child doesn't bring any toys from home.** They may bring in a bag for their reading book. Children who usually have a packed lunch will need to bring this with them. The children will not need a PE bag.
- Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit (white PE top, maroon PE shorts or black tracksuit bottoms, Marton sweatshirt and pumps or trainers) on their PE days. You will be notified of the days your child will be doing PE in the first newsletter in September.

We very much look forward to seeing you all in September. I would like to thank you all for your ongoing consideration and support.
