In support of '**Children in Need**' children are invited to wear their own clothes for the day in return for a voluntary donation of **£1** per child or **£2** per family. We hope you will join us in supporting this worthwhile cause. (***Please note that donations for this event are entirely voluntary.***)



On **Friday 3rd December 2021**, we will be having a unique non-uniform day in honour of the millions of people who have served in the NHS and emergency services. This is part of a campaign called **#UniteTheUniforms for the @999Cenotaph**.

The campaign will see students invited to **wear the colours of the emergency services** (red, blue, green or orange) and **donating £1** towards building the UK's first 'Emergency Services Cenotaph' which is supported by **His Royal Highness The Duke of Cambridge, the Prime Minister and First Ministers of NI, Scotland and Wales.**



Our message is simple: Bullying will not be tolerated at our school - you must **TELL** an adult.

As part of our anti-bullying work this term, we are looking at respect which links directly to our three Doobee Rules which are, Do be respectful of yourself, Do be respectful of others and Do be proud of your school.

We have been looking at the definition of bullying, the different forms that it can take and what the children should do if either they are being bullied or they know someone who is. We have agreed that bullying is repeated behaviour that causes distress to the victim.

We have agreed that bullying can be:

- Emotional - being unfriendly, excluding, tormenting (e.g. hiding books, threatening gestures);
- Physical - pushing, kicking, hitting, punching or any use of violence;
- Racist - racial taunts, graffiti, gestures;
- Verbal - name-calling, sarcasm, spreading rumours, teasing;
- Cyber - all areas of internet, such as email & internet chat rooms, misuse of mobiles such as sending threats by text messaging & calls.

We encourage children to TELL an adult straight away if either they or someone they know is being bullied. For further details, please refer to our Anti- Bullying Policy published on our website

Year Three will be videoing their anti-bullying assembly and we will be sharing it with our school community. It can be accessed on our school website.

Booking Deadline

On **Tuesday, 14th December** we are having our Christmas lunch. The cost of the lunch is **£2 per child**. If your child is currently on packed lunches and would like to have a Christmas lunch, please pay £2 on **Parent Pay under Christmas Lunch, no later than Friday, 3rd December 2021**. **If your child is already on hot dinners, you do not need to book on this system.**

Please note that if your child is already having school dinners they will be automatically included. If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or 2 and would like a dinner that day please contact the office as you do not need to pay.

Unfortunately, as food orders are made in advance, no late requests or refunds can be accommodated.



Flu Vaccination

Blackpool Teaching Hospitals have enhanced the consent process by transforming a previously paper process into a streamlined electronic form accessible anywhere. Previously receiving consent for a child's vaccine was reliant on school staff handing the paper forms out and getting them home to their parents/guardians, increasing the potential for the form being lost. Now the child's school will email or text the link to the consent form (also unique school code) to the parents/guardians so that they can easily and quickly complete the consent form via mobile device, tablet or computer. This will save parent/carers time and free up school staff time. Once your child has been vaccinated you will also be notified by text ensuring that you are up to date with the child's vaccinations. The vaccination team will be in school in November.
