## Silver Guitar award

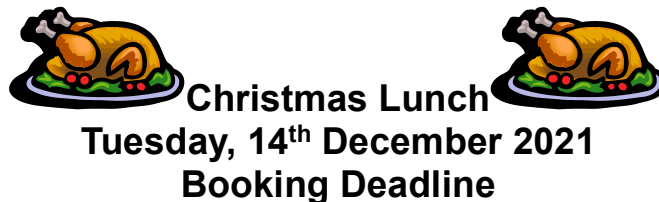
